Triggered by a local story still told in his native Dundee, Stuart McHardy has traced what seems to be memories of groups of nine women across much of Europe and as far as Siberia, Korea, India and Africa. Whether as Pictish saints, Muses, Valkyries, Druidesses or witches, the tales of these groups of nine women transcend a vast range of cultural and linguistic boundaries.

From the mothers of the Norse God Heimdall, Morgan and her sisters on Avalon, to the nine sisters at the heart of the myth of the Gikuyu of Kenya, these women stand out in history and mythology. The painting of nine women dancing around a priapic male in a Catalonian cave painting over fifteen thousand years old suggests these groups may have been one of the oldest cultural institutions humanity has known.
