1780	Discourse delivered by Rt. Hon. Earl of Buchan at meeting to promote a society of antiquarian interests in Scotland.
1780 - 1828	Statutes of Society and list of members
1778-1787	"Papers relating to the Society of Antiquaries of Scotland". Bound volume circulars and correspondence relating to the founding of the society. includes the Discourse delivered by the Earl of Buchan, the statutes of Society etc.

Recommendation	s of Fellows
1815-1828	Ms. and printed forms of recommendation. Printed forms include ms. name of "A Gentleman well skilled in many branches of polite learning" and desire their admission as Ordinary, Fellow or Corresponding members of the Society. Signed by 3 or 4 members of the society, dated and later inscribed with the date of admission
